- NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED, WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE. Entry fees shall not be refunded for the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of the entry fee will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snowstorms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors, and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance, and, in the event, it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of the entry fee will be made.
